 - o Licence, Club Membership Card of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club
 - o Log Book (if issued)

Class J; Juniors NOTES: Juniors are defined as being over 12 years but less than 18 years of age on the day of the first round (06th March) Refer NMC 10.(h) Novices are defined as competitors in their first year of competition All persons driving a special will compete in the special Class F Classes and Categories for the VKC shall be: Class A: Production Cars: Production Cars: 0 to 1600cc Class C: Production Cars: Greater than 1600cc to 3000cc Class C: Production Cars: Greater than 3000cc Class G: 4-Wheel Drive Production Cars Class MP2: Highly Modified 2-Wheel Drive Production Cars, ie. TYRES	For Bitumen events tyres used are open but must not have canvas or steel showing. Spare tyres, which may be used during the event, shall be scrutinized along with the vehicle.
VEHICLES WITHOUT WINDSCREENS	Drivers of vehicles without windscreens must wear appropriate eye-protection as per Motorsport Australia requirements and South Eastern Automobile Club Khanacross Series 2022 Standing Regulations
PASSENGERS	Junior competitors may request a Motorsport Australia Speed Licensed or superior. SEAC member as a passenger/instructor for the non-competitive component of the event. Approval must be given from the Clerk of the Course prior to any passenger entering a vehicle. Passengers must sign a "Passenger in Vehicle Disclaimer Form" (even if they are also a driver on the day) and comply with the supplementary regulations and current MSPRA requirements.

METHOD OF SCORING	Placing's shall be decided on the aggregate of elapsed time on the tests completed, plus any penalties. The winner/s shall be the driver/s having the lowest aggregate, including any penalties, at the completion of the event. In the case of equal scores, the State Championship shall be decided using the Motorsport Australia championship and series policy, section 7, where the winner will be decided on a count back format.	
VARIATIONS TO KHANACROSS REGULATIONS:	 (a) Clause 13.4 (viii) which deals with penalties for 'striking a marker', is varied with the addition of the words, "and significantly displaced from its original position". (b) Clause 13.4 (iv) that deals with reversing after crossing a designated finish line, the penalty is changed to "plus five seconds". (c) Every marker knocked carries a separate penalty of "plus 5 seconds". (d) Diagrams may be provided for each course.

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

COVID or other PANDEMICS:
